Private Pilot Privileges (Canadian Aviation Regulations 401.26)

The holder of a private pilot licence – aeroplane may act as

- a) Pilot-in-Command or co-pilot of an aeroplane of a class and type in respect of which the licence is endorsed with ratings;
- b) Pilot-in-command of an ultra-light aeroplane
- c) Pilot-in-command or co-pilot of any aircraft for the sole purpose of the holder's flight training or flight
 - -in the case of flight training, is conducted under the direct supervision of a flight instructor and no passengers are carried on board
 - -in he case of a flight test no other passengers on board other than the flight examiner
