Mitchinson Flight Centre **Vaccination Policy for Customers** **at the Saskatoon Airport**

Objective

The objective of this policy is to reduce the transmission of COVID-19 to protect the health and safety of the Flight Centre's Community Members. The Saskatoon Airport Authority has been mandated by Transport Canada that anyone accessing airport property be fully vaccinated. We have adopted this policy to come into effect immediately, with proof of vaccination starting November 15, 2021.

Scope

This policy applies to all airport campus tenants including anyone connected to the aviation system at the Saskatoon Airport. For clarity, this policy applies to all individuals or organizations operating on Saskatoon Airport property other than a stand-alone non-aviation business.

Proof of Vaccination

MFC has established a requirement that all persons who wish to have access to our facilities and resources MUST be fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated is defined as the individual having received:

- the full series of an authorized COVID-19 vaccine, or an acceptable combination of; and
- the last dose at least 14 full days prior to the day you wish to fly

Vaccination status will be verified upon arrival at the facility. To maintain the highest level of personal privacy and protection of your information, please do NOT forward

any vaccination information via email and do NOT provide photocopies of vaccination information for us to keep. Once a customer has provided proof of vaccination, they will not be required to show it again, unless the definition to be fully vaccinated changes. MFC will securely store the status of individuals' vaccination status for future booking reference.

Mitchinson Flight Centre will also honour proof of APPROVED medical and religious exemptions. Please contact your health authority and/or Transport Canada if you believe one of these exemptions applies to your situation.

Individuals with a medical or religious exemption must undergo an antigen test and demonstrate a negative test result twice every seven (7) days. The official result paperwork of each negative test must be shown upon entry to the flight centre.

COVID-19 Prevention Measures

Any individual who receives a positive result for a COVID-19 test, other than a molecular test must receive a result of a molecular COVID-19 test. Any individual who receives a positive result for a COVID-19 molecular test is prohibited from accessing any part of the airport for a period of 14 days after the result was received or until the person is not exhibiting any symptoms whichever is later.
